- **Park county Vaccine Notification System - 1B Over 80 Years of Age Phone Signup**
- **Park City-County Health Department Asks Residents to Sign Up to Receive Local Covid-19 Vaccine Information**

Livingston, MT-The Park City-County Health Department has partnered with Nixle to utilize the Community Notification System to provide Park County residents with up-to-date information about Covid-19 and vaccine availability.

To receive Nixle notifications, a Park County resident can:

1. Text their zip code to 888-777, or
2. Sign up online at <https://local.nixle.com/register/>

After registering, a confirmation text will be sent to the user's mobile device. Nixle is a reliable, safe, and timely way to receive accurate information and updates about the Covid-19 vaccine in Park County.

Dr. Desnick, Health Officer said "as we learn more from the state about vaccine plans and availability, we will update Park County residents using Nixle alerts. Many people are excited to receive a vaccine and Nixle will allow us to provide our community with timely and accurate information about Covid-19 vaccines."

Further, Park County will be ready to begin vaccinations for Phase 1B upon delivery of vaccine. They are focusing on residents 80 years and older as the majority of deaths in the county are in that age group. Understanding that many of these residents are not using social media or text messaging, they are asking the community to reach out to that population to have them call 222-4145 or 222 4131 to sign up for a notification as vaccine is available.
