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Advisory #6

Below is the FAQ guidance we received from Dept. of Commerce in regard to the additional funding:

Q: How much can I receive?

The maximum payment is \$10,000 or nine months of working capital. Up to a cumulative total for all rounds of the grant of \$30,000.

Q: I forgot my Submittable password, how can I log in?

Q: I only see information on how to apply for a Local Government Grant. Where do I go?

First, make sure you are logged in to your Submittable account. Then, click on the “View Your Submissions” link in the upper right corner. This will take you to the log in screen for your grant.

Q: My bank account information has changed, how can I update it?

Notify us via email at reliefapps.covid@mt.gov if your bank account info has changed. *Do not share your bank account information via email.* In Submittable, please accept the payment form, and a check will be mailed.

Q: I didn't apply for the Business Stabilization Program and have not previously received a grant through this program. Am I able to apply?

No. The program is not accepting new applications.

Q: Are there other grants I can apply to?

If your business is in a position to rehire workers laid off due to COVID, you may be eligible for the Big Sky Economic Development Trust Fund Workforce Recovery Program. Learn more at MARKETMT.COM.

Q: I'm losing revenue and need additional support, what am I supposed to do?

We recommend calling your U.S. Congressperson – Senator Jon Tester, Senator Steve Daines or Rep. Greg Gianforte. Congress has not approved any new support measures or stimulus for businesses since March.
