All Montanans will be eligible for COVID-19 Vaccine April 1

- Governor Gianforte announced today that the COVID Vaccine will be available to all residents on April 1, 2021.
- Over 142,000 Montana residents, accounting for 13% of the state's population have been fully immunized.
- This will open up vaccinations to all of those over the age of 16. The Pfizer vaccine is available to those 16 and older, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines are available to those 18 and older.
- Availability will still be tied to supply allocated to the state.
- The federally allocated programs at pharmacies will continue to follow federal scheduling and phasing.
