Changes to Vaccination Program on 4/1/21**

On Thursday, April 1, the COVID-19 Vaccine becomes available to all residents 16 years and older. The process for obtaining a vaccination appointment will be changing to accommodate this new phase as follows:

Gallatin County:

- While the vaccine eligibility will be expanded, Gallatin County will continue to prioritize access to people in the 1B+ and 1A groups.
- **On March 31, 2021, all Gallatin County residents can sign up for a spot on a COVID-19 vaccine waiting list.**
- A link for this waiting list will go live on the [Healthy Gallatin website](#) on Wednesday, March 31, at 12:00 p.m.
- When vaccine doses are available, they will send an email to as many people as they have doses, based on their priority. The email will contain a unique link allowing you to sign up for a one appointment. The link will also be good for 48 hours securing your opportunity to register.

In addition to the Gallatin County-City Health Department, vaccines will also be available through Bozeman Health, CHP and MSU who will be reaching out to their patients/communities to schedule appointments as they receive doses. The federal pharmacy allocation is also an option. You can find available vaccine and book an appointment for these at VACCINEFINDER.ORG.

Park County:

On April 1, 2021 Park county providers are collaborating for a one-day event to offer COVID vaccine in celebration and gratitude to the front-line workers in the community **age 18 and older***.

The event will be held at the Park County Fairgrounds, Thursday, April 1.

Appointments can be made starting March 26 and will remain open until full.

Beginning April 2nd, all Park County residents aged 18 and older* can sign up for an appointment [On their website](#). First doses will be available on Thursdays at the Park County fairgrounds. The county is currently receiving 500 doses a week.

***Note that Park County is offering appointments for those 18, rather than 16, and older. This is due to the current county allocation being primarily the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccine which is approved for the 18 and older population.**
